Accomplishments and activities related goals:

The committee has been able to conduct business via email correspondence since all live in various parts of the State. We all were in attendance at the TSO Convention in Waco and the International Convention in Austin and were able to discuss matters.

The committee was able to update the application form for this fund in Spanish so that members could better understand the requirements. The forms were streamlined as well. The Eula Lee Carter Memorial Fund pages on the TSO website were updated with the current Guidelines and Application forms, and the address of the chairman will appear from now on as the recipient of the applications.

The committee was able to give a brief presentation during a session of the Latin American Forum for members of the DKG chapters from Latin American countries at the International Convention in July of 2018. Several application requests were submitted as a result of this contact.

One grant of \$750 has been presented this year, with another to be presented this spring if the payment arrangements can be made.
