# University of Texas Endowed Scholarships

**Are you thinking of working on a graduate degree and you live in one of these cities?**

Arlington, Austin, Dallas, El Paso, Permian Basin, Rio Grande Valley,  
San Antonio, or Tyler

The University of Texas has 3 endowed TSO Scholarships named in honor of our founders: Annie Webb Blanton, Mamie Sue Bastian, and Eula Lee Carter. We have funds restricted to students pursuing graduate or doctoral degrees at one of the UT system schools.

The UT System Board of Regents has granted approval for our applicants to receive scholarships from the University of Texas held endowments for courses of study at any of these UT system schools. A DKG member who is officially enrolled at one of the UT schools for coursework toward a degree, whether on-site or on-line, would be eligible for support from these scholarships.

Any applicant wanting to apply for one of these scholarships would have to apply to the Texas State Scholarship Committee using the current forms and designate that their school of choice to attend was one of the UT system schools. She would have to be enrolled as a student. If awarded, the Scholarship Committee Chair would arrange for the candidate to complete paperwork specific to the University of Texas System to attain the funds.
